Brief description of Topic Salient characteristic of Primates

Salient characteristic of the order - primate are as follows:-

1. The limbs are prehensile (ability to grasp) and adapted for arboreal life. This was probably an earliest mammalian characteristic
2. Either the thumb or the great toe or both are opposable
3. The primate bear flat nails upon their digits. This makes the grasping function of the hands and feet easier.
4. The presence of well-developed clavicle is a characteristic feature of the primate. Such a development facilitates the movement of arms.
