South East Manipur College, Komlathabi: At a Glance

South East Manipur College, Komlathabi is a premier Co-education College located along the state highway No.10, at Komlathabi village in Chandel District. It was established in 1981 during the times when parents, guardian & students were running out of options for further studies in general line. The college has been affiliated to Manipur University till date with permanent affiliation since 1992. The University Grants Commission recognizes the College under section 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act, 1956. It has also been updated to a Model Degree College by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under Rashtriya Uchchattar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) in the Year 2018. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore has accredited the college with grade B++ (2nd Cycle) on February 14, 2023.

The institution became a full-fledged Government College vide Government Order no. 31/3/AIDED-COL/CONVSN/HE-16(MSSW) dated 29th January, 2020. Since then, the institution has been administered under the supervision of the Manipur Government's Directorate of University and Higher Education. The Principal serves as the Institutional Head.

We offer courses in Science, Arts, Physical Education, Food Processing Technology and BCA upto the Degree level.

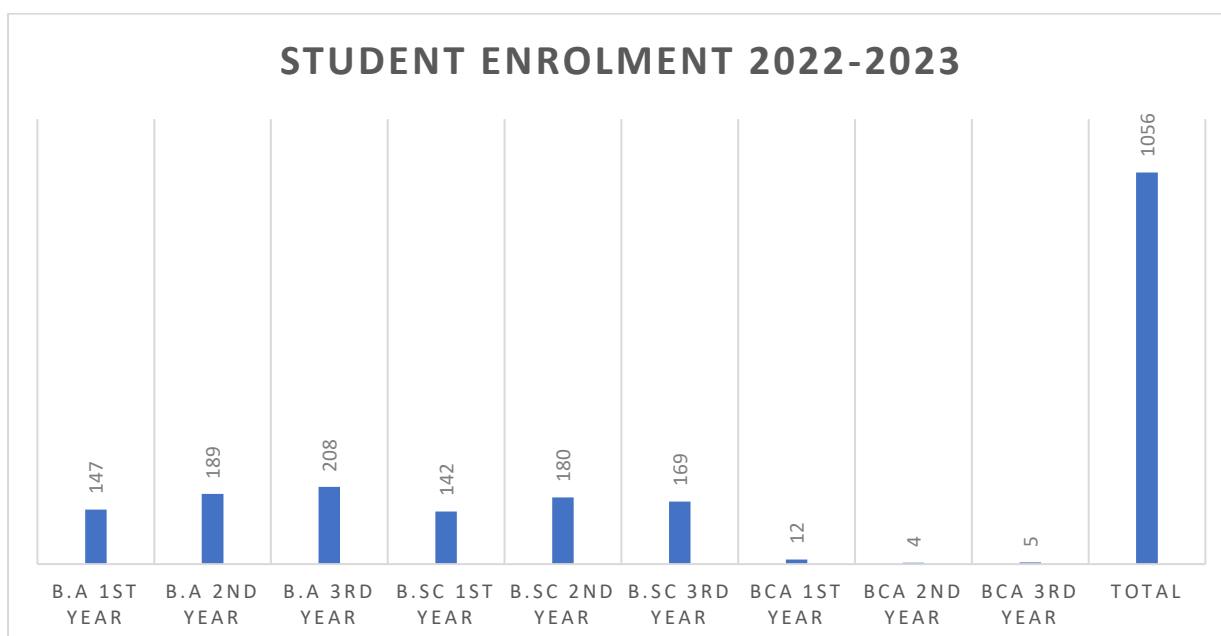

- The total number of students admitted/enrolled in BA/B.Sc/BCA for the academic session 2022-2023 is 1056.

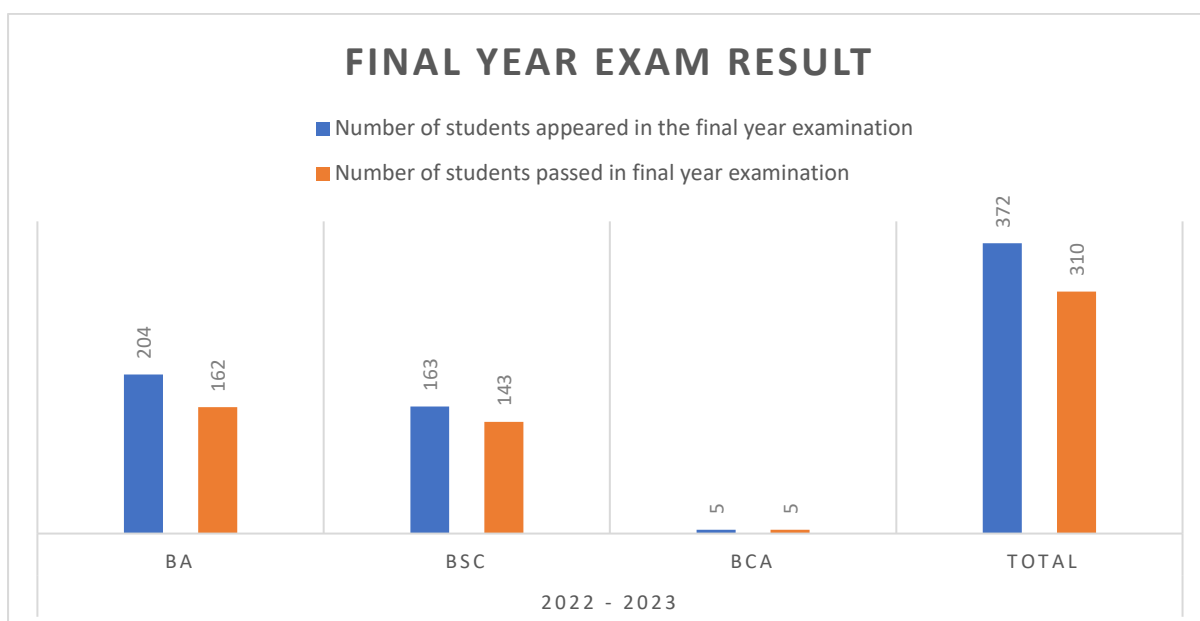
