

Additional details for Extension activities

1. Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB), December 2019- February 2020

Under the campaign of the government of India for Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat, the EBSB Club was formed in December 2019. Institutions in India were paired to carry out Student Exchange and Teacher Exchange programmes. SEMCO college was paired with Government Nilkantheshwar P.G college, Khandwa, Madhya Pradesh. Student exchange with the paired college was done through video conferencing. Watching of movie of the paired state, showing historical places, competitions on their history was organised under this programme. These activities exposed the students to the culture of the state and interaction with the students of the paired student was beneficial too. These activities enable the students to grow and learn many things which will be useful in their life.

2. Observation of Swachhta Pakhwada, 16-31 January 2020

Swachhta Pakhwada programme was taken up in January 16 till 31 January 2020 wherein a plan of activities was conducted in the college as per the instruction of the government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, and Department of Higher Education EBSB cell. Students' oriented programmes were taken up to create awareness among them in all aspects of Swachhta-personal, physical, mental, environmental, societal etc. Activities like plantation of saplings, cleanliness drive, waste management, special drive on water conservation, competitions like slogan writing, poster making were organised for the students.

3. NCC for girls was introduced in 2020. 106 girls cadets were enrolled in the college NCC. The girls were trained in respect to discipline, drill, punctuality etc which is helpful for their holistic development.

4. SEMCO Red Cross Society

This society was formed in November 2021. Social services were organised through this club and lectures were also given to students on the role, importance and benefits of the Red Cross Society.

5. Electoral Literacy Club(ELC) was formed on November 2021. Under the instruction of the Directorate of University and Higher Education, Government of Manipur, Awareness for National Voter Awareness Contest was organised on March 29, 2022. Students participated in singing competition on My vote is my future, the power of one vote.

6. Besides, Some of the local college staffs and students collaborated with the local Village eco care club known as Kapaam Eco Care. And under this, various activities were taken up to fight environmental degradation.

Besides ,the college observes important days like World environment Day,Matribhasa Day, Teachers Day ,International Yoga day etc from time to time attended by staffs and students creating awareness to them for such important issues.
