Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes:

Some of the course objectives and learning outcomes are as follows:

A. Course Objectives:

2. To introduce the general foundation of philosophy and education and study its interrelationship.
3. To provide an understanding of the meaning and importance of sociology, relationship between sociology and education, concepts and scopes of sociology of education and educational sociology.
4. To study the methods of Educational Psychology and the relationship between education and psychology.
5. The course will provide an understanding about the development of Education in India, Ancient and Medieval System of Education, Education before and after Indian Independence.
6. To provide an understanding of Educational Management and Administration.
7. The course will enable the students to know the need and importance of guidance and counselling in education.
8. The course will enable the students to understand the concept, needs, approaches of Educational Technology and innovations in Educational Technology.
9. To understand the nature and scope of curriculum development, curriculum design and evaluation and reform of curriculum.

10. To study the concept, nature and scope of inclusive education, Children With Special Needs (CWSN), techniques and aids for the education of CWSN, policies and programs of inclusion.
11. To study educational measurement and evaluation, tools and techniques of educational evaluation and characteristics of a good measuring instruments.
12. To study the importance of educational statistics.
13. The course will enable the students to understand the Psychodynamic concept of adjustment, maladjusted individual and their education.
14. The course will enable the students to understand parenting and child care education.
15. To study the fundamentals of educational research.
16. The course will enable the students to know about the renowned educational thinkers and their philosophies.
17. To analyse the contemporary issues and trends in Indian Education.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Students will acquire meaning, nature, knowledge of education and their interrelationship.
2. Students will know the general foundations of philosophy and education and the philosophical ideas about education are built up.
3. Students will understand the importance of Sociology, relationship between Sociology and Education and Educational Sociology.
