- 7. To understand the history, philosophical and environmental dimensions of problems and issues facing education.


## PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOMES: The students should be able

- To understand sociology of education, educational management and administration, educational measurement and evaluation, curriculum construction, teacher education, guidance and counselling.


