COURSE OUTCOMES

SEMESTER – I COURSE CODE: ELECTIVE ENGLISH (101)

SEMESTER – II COURSE CODE: ELECTIVE ENGLISH (202)
(British Fiction).

After Completion of this course, Students will be able to learn the elements of fiction of British Literature. They will know and understand more the literary genre of Novel and short story and literary devices of allegory and metaphor, satire and Stream of consciousness technique. Enhance their reading skills and know how to express their ideas creatively and critically.

SEMESTER – III COURSE CODE: ELECTIVE ENGLISH (303)
(Western Criticism).

At the end of this course, Students will be able to learn the history of literary criticism and understand the function of it upon studying the origin of critical ideas in literature from Plato to present.

SEMESTER – IV COURSE CODE: ELECTIVE ENGLISH (404)
(Linguistics and English Language).

Upon completion of this course, Students will be familiar with the key concepts of linguistics and the latest trends in language study. They will know specific sounds and understand systematic properties of sound system of English including Phonetics, Phonology, Morphology, Syntax, Semantics, and Pragmatics.

SEMESTER – V
COURSE CODE: ENGLISH HONOURS (505)
(Twentieth Century British Literature).

At the end of this course, Students will be able to know the major issues related to the cultural and social context of the British society in the 20th century. They will also be familiar with the new literature of Britain with the important concepts, themes and traditions in the British literature and contemporary British literature of the 20th century.

COURSE CODE: ENGLISH HONOURS (506)
(Indian Writing in English)

At the end of this course, Students will be familiar with the major Indian writers and their works of literature in English. They would also know the various phases of the evolution of Indian writing with the thematic concerns, genres, and trends of Indian writing in English.

(Literary Theory)

After completion of this course, Students will know the critical ideas, values and themes in the literary texts. Learn the history of various literary theories and know how to apply various literary theories in interpreting a specific text.
